#### Trajectory of the Institute for 105 Years

- \* Established in 1914 as a School Of Dyeing & Printing
- \* In the year 1937, it was renamed as a Government Central Textile Institute with merger of the textile technology department of the then Thomson Engineering College, Roorkee (now I.I.T. Roorkee). It excelled as a sole and premier textile institute of Northern India.
- \* In the year 1959- 60, four year degree programmes were initiated in Textile Technology and Textile Chemistry affiliated with Agra University.
- \* It was affiliated to Kanpur University when it came into being in the year 1966.
- \* In the year 1976-77, a four year degree programme in Man Made Fibre Technology was also initiated in the Institute.
- \* In the year 1985, the three year diploma courses were transferred to the Government Polytechnic, Kanpur and post graduate, doctoral programmes were started in the Institute.
- \* In the year 2005, another four year degree programme in Textile Engineering was started with the help of World Bank under TEQIP (Technical Education Quality Improvement) scheme of Govt. of India.

Thus, our Institute made a remarkable journey of it's development since the inception. Today, it is all equipped with the required paraphernalia for graduate, post graduate and doctoral programmes in the field of textiles.

#### About OBA:

A baby step in 1940 converted into a long remarkable journey. A handful of persons laid the foundation of Old Boys Association of Government Central Textile Institute in the year 1940 and got it registered on 7th September 1944 under the Society Act.
